Pagham Cricket Club follows the guidance issued in 'Safe Hands – Welfare of Young People in Cricket' on the use of images of Young People which is available at <http://www.ecb.co.uk/safehands>. Pagham Cricket Club will take steps to ensure that these images are used solely for the purpose they are intended, which is the promotion and celebration of cricketing activities.

If photographs e.g. team or action shots, are submitted to the Press or published on Pagham Cricket Club website individuals will not ordinarily be identified. Where a child or young person is identified it will only be with the explicit consent of parents.

Please note: Pagham Cricket Club understands that there are circumstances under which a parent would not wish their child to be photographed. Whilst Pagham Cricket Club will do all that it can to ensure the safety of children during photographed events, it is the responsibility of the parent concerned to ensure that if their child is not to be photographed and partakes in an activity and is by the nature of the activity inadvertently photographed or filmed, Pagham Cricket Club cannot be held responsible.

Section 8 – General Data Protection Regulation

The club has issued guidelines relating to General Data Protection Regulation as it affects junior members.

- I confirm by ticking and signing this form you are confirming you have received and read the Policy relating to General Data Protection Regulation as it affects junior members (see Player's & Parents Copy of Pagham Cricket Club Junior Section Policies). The Club will use the information provided on the Junior Membership Form (together with other information it obtains about the player & parents) to administer his/her cricketing activity at the Club and in any activities in which he/she participates through the Club and to care for and supervise activities in which he/she is involved. In some cases this may require the Club to disclose the information to County Boards, Leagues and to the England and Wales Cricket Board. In the event of a medical issue or child protection issue arising, the Club may disclose certain information to doctors or other medical specialists and/or to police, children's social care, the Courts and/or probation officers and, potentially to legal and other advisers involved in an investigation.
- I confirm by ticking and signing the Club will communicate regarding club matters, fixtures, training, sporting and social events and other activities that are happening at or involving the Pagham Cricket Club.

Section 9 – E-safety policy

The club has issued guidelines relating to e-safety as it affects junior members.

- Take responsibility for their own use of communication and interactive technologies, making sure they use new technologies safely, responsibly and legally within the context of cricket
 - No communication device or service, including interactive communication services such as social networking may be used to bring the club, its members or cricket into disrepute
 - No communication device or service, including interactive services such as social networking may be used for inappropriate behaviour online within the context of cricket including the bullying or harassment of others in any form, defamation, obscene or abusive language, the uploading of material which is libellous, defamatory, obscene, illegal, shows nudity or is violent
 - Report any known misuses of communication and interactive technologies within the context of cricket, including unacceptable behaviour, inappropriate contact with children online and illegal content including sexual abuse/indecent images of children, according to the relevant club and ECB safeguarding policies and procedures
 - Need to be aware that any report of the misuse of communication and interactive technologies within the context of cricket will be investigated according to the club's policy and procedures and may result in the club's sanctions being enforced. Depending upon the seriousness of the incident legal action may be taken and where suspected criminal activity has taken place a report will be made to the police

Section 10 – Transport to matches and practice sessions

The club has issued guidelines for transport to matches and practice sessions as it affects junior members. Pagham Cricket Club policy is that parents or other responsible adults are responsible for transporting players to and from all matches and practice sessions. The Club will not be registering Private Vehicles for the transportation of individuals in connection with any fixtures or practice sessions arranged by the Club. The implementation of this policy is not intended to exclude any player from participation and parents or guardians should contact the Club’s Junior Coordinator, if they have any problems with the transportation to matches or practice sessions.

- Parental consent must be given if Young Players are to share changing facilities with adults.
- If Young Players are sharing changing facilities with adults when playing in senior teams, parents have the option to supervise.
